As chairman of the Historic Property Grant Program Committee, it gives me great pleasure to present to the Prince George's County Planning Board the committee's recommendations for grant awards.

A total of 14 applications were received and compiled by Historic Preservation Section staff. Requests for grant funds totaled \$1,069,139 of an available \$250,000. Nine projects received partial funding, with the top-scoring projects designated to receive additional funds in the event an award is not accepted. Committee members reviewed and scored each application individually; the scores were then averaged. Please find attached for your review a table of the recommended awards showing each project's average score, the proposed grant award, and the proposed percentage awarded to each project.

Historic Preservation Commission Chairman David Turner and I look forward to presenting the Grants to these most deserving historical projects along with you, our County Executive, and the Councilmember from the respective District at each historical project site.
