BOWIE HIGH SCHOOL Libraries and Community Centers

Hospitals

Fire/Emergency Services



Schools





LIBRARIES & COMMUNITY CENTERS



- Two libraries Bowie & South Bowie branches
- Three centers Huntington, Bowie, South Bowie



- Growing disparity between the old & new neighborhoods
- City of Bowie has the best access



HOSPITALS





- Nearly all residents within the 21-minute (national average) threshold hospital access in suburban areas
- Bowie Health Clinic provides health services & includes a small emergency room



FIRE/EMERGENCY SERVICES & POLICE





- Fire/EMS department is siting three possible locations along Church Road for a new station
- Majority of calls are EMS calls
- City of Bowie is better covered by police beats
- Church Road and east of US 301 is poorly covered by police beats



SCHOOLS



- All schools (except three) in plan area within target utilization range of 85 to 100 percent or below 85
- Utilizations rate growing unevenly across the plan area and the County
- PGCPS is undertaking a comprehensive boundary study to balance utilization

Do you feel that your area is adequately served by fire/EMS services? If not, where do you think fire stations/EMS are needed?




Do you feel that your area is adequately served by police services? If not, where do you think police presence is needed?






