The Property is an operating car dealership and is within an area containing other automobile-oriented and service uses. The Property is located in the TAC-e zone where automobile dealerships are not a permitted use. The 2022 Approved Bowie-Mitchellville and Vicinity Master Plan recommends that the zoning of the Property be changed from TAC-e to CS. The property owner supports the recommended zoning change and requests that the change be reflected in and implemented by the SMA. The change to the CS zone complies with the Master Plan as noted below:

The Property was rezoned from the C-M Zone to the TAC-e Zone by the CMA because at the time it was within the boundaries of the Bowie Local Town Center. The Adopted Master Plan amended the boundary of the Town Center. This amended boundary removed the Property from the Bowie Local Town Center. The boundary amendment is depicted on Map 22, page 61 of the Master Plan. In conjunction with this amendment, Land Use Policy 4.4 was revised as follows:

LU 4.4 Remove certain properties east of US 301 (Robert Crain Highway) south of US 50/US 301 (John Hanson Highway) from the Bowie Local Town Center and put into the Established Communities policy area, so that limited mixed-use redevelopment, and automobile-oriented and service uses can be located east of the freeway (see CZ 4.1, 4.2, and 4.3; Map 22. Bowie Local Town Center-Center Boundary Amendment; Map 25. Plan 2035 Growth Policy Map Amendments; and Appendix B. Plan 2035 and Functional Master Plan Amendments).

In accordance with LU 4.4, the Land Use Map (Map 16, P. 50) was updated to reflect commercial use for the Property.

Consistent with this Land Use modifications, Table 18, CZ 4.1, page 84 recommends the following zoning changes to be implemented with the Comprehensive Rezoning:

16600 Governors Bridge Road (Tax ID 0801472) from the TAC-E Zone to the CS Zone;

16620 Governors Bridge Road (Tax ID 3319803) from the TAC-E Zone to the CS Zone;

16700 Governors Bridge Road (Tax ID 3319811) from the TAC-E Zone to the CS Zone;

Based upon the above, the proposed CS Zone clearly complies with the 2022 Approved Bowie-Mitchellville and Vicinity Master Plan and the owner of the property supports this change.

In completing this form, you should also review §§ 5-833 to 5-839 of the Public Ethics Law. Please note that under §5-835(a) of the Public Ethics Law, payments/contributions during the pendency of an application are generally prohibited.
