

The Approved Master Plan and Sectional Map
Amendment for Subregion 1 contains several policies
and strategies aimed at providing a more walkable
and urban street form to the US Route 1 corridor.
Much of this requires investment and development
which has yet to happen

boundary




Study Area Zoning

Study Area - Land Uses


















Study Area - Pedestrian Conditions



The Approved Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for Subregion 1 : Goals

Development

- Encourage small-scale, neighborhood-serving, retail uses along the US 1 Corridor to meet gaps in the marketplace.
- Provide high-quality mixed-use development along US
- Eliminate substandard, marginal uses and properties, along the US 1 Corridor that need major structural repair and/or promote an unsafe, low -quality setting.



The Approved Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for Subregion 1 : Goals

Mobility

 Provide a pedestrian-friendly environment that is a safe and enjoyable place to walk.

Design

- Develop design standards and guidelines for achieving high-quality development and improving the form and character of development along the corridor.
- Support a quality urban design framework.


