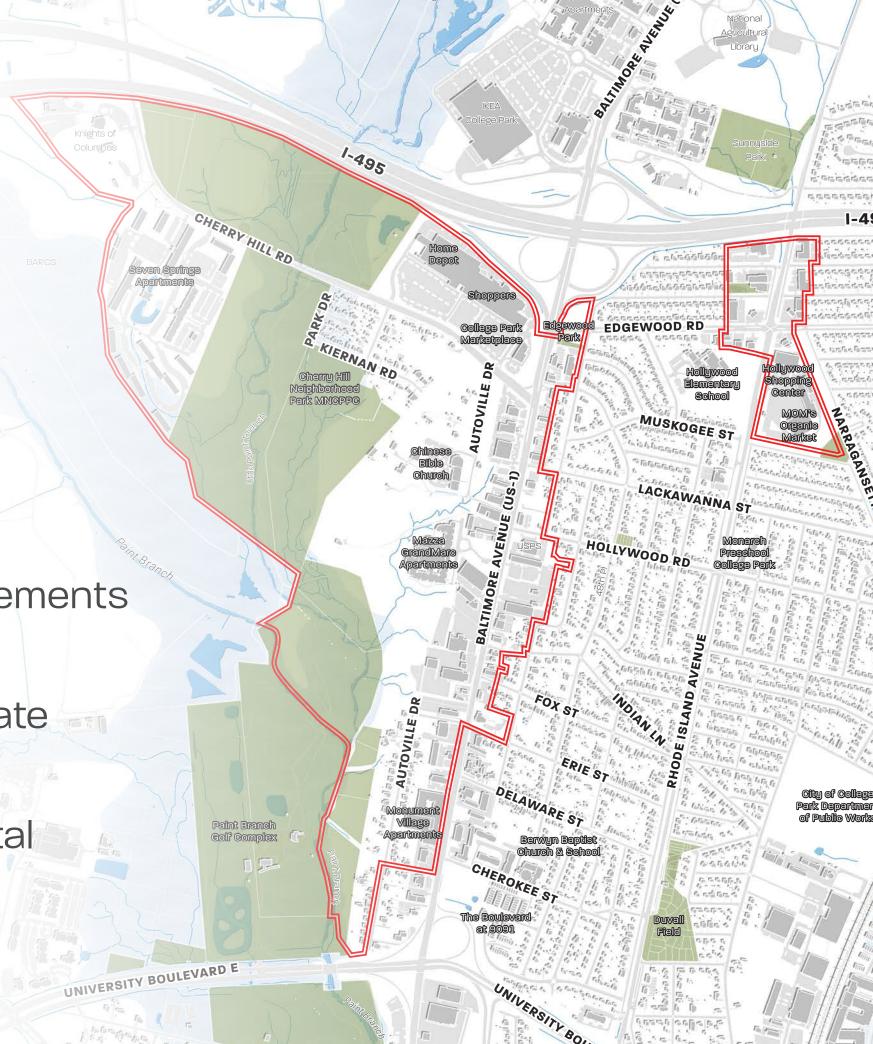


PURPOSE

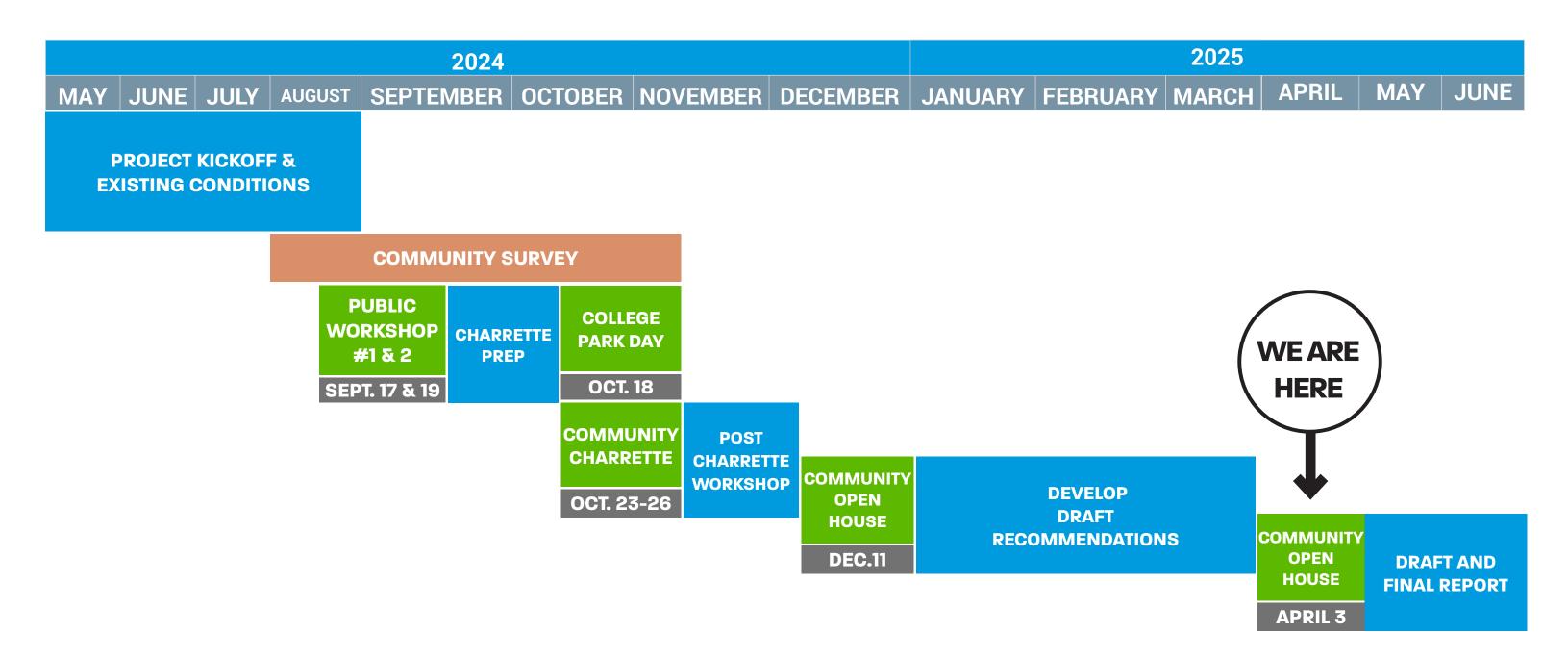
The purpose of the Central US Route 1 Neighborhood Compatibility Study is to inform next steps for the study area, informed by the project's goals, objectives and recommendations

This may include, for example:

- » Policy and/or zoning changes
- » Infrastructure / streetscape improvements
- » Placemaking and Wayfinding
- » Consideration of a Sector Plan update
- » Map amendments
- » Prioritization and/or funding of capital projects

Study Area Vision

Transform Baltimore Avenue and the Hollywood Commercial District into a vibrant, attractive, and pedestrian-friendly corridor / place that celebrates the neighborhood's cultural, natural, and economic assets

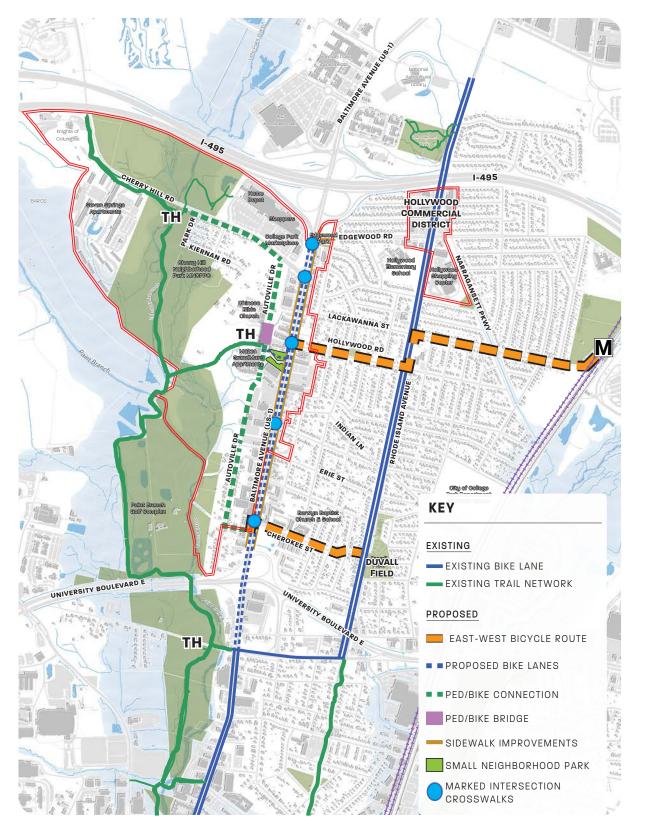
Pedestrian and Bicycle Network Plan

- » Create two safe east-west pedestrian and bicycle routes along:
 - Lackawanna and Hollywood Roads
 - Cherokee Street
- » Use sharrows, signage, and sidewalk graphics to guide cyclists
- » Create a visible bicycle crossing at Hollywood Road and Cherokee Street
- » Add sidewalks on neighborhood streets where appropriate/supported (needs further study with community)
- » Designate Autoville Drive as a shared street (study trail connection behind auto dealers + ped/bike bridge at Paint Branch TH)
- » Sign Rhode Island, Autoville, and the Paint Branch Trail as north-south routes
- » Add crosswalks to all legs of intersections
- » Consider barrier-separated bike lanes on US Route1 as part of Phase 2/3 improvements (needs further study and coordination with DPW&T and SHA - may require ROW acquisition or easements)









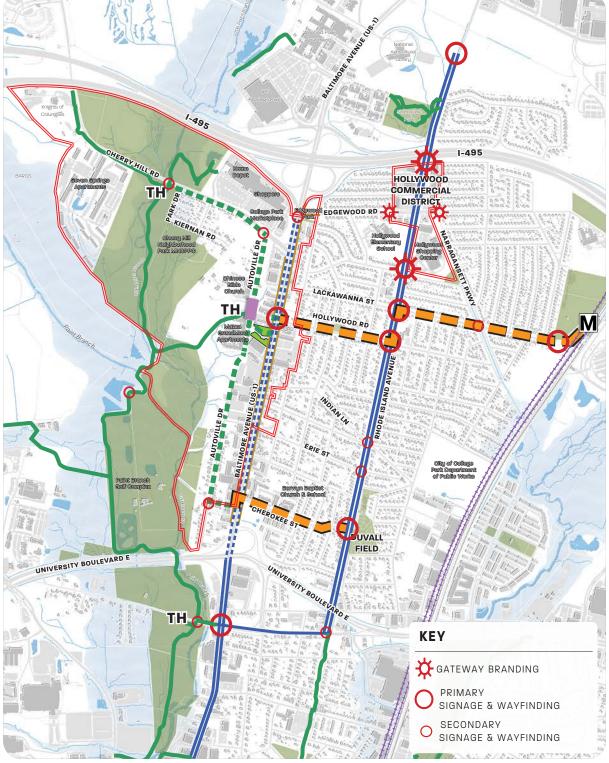
Branding, Wayfinding, & Placemaking

- » Add Monumental gateway signage on Rhode Island Avenue to celebrate the Hollywood Commercial District
- » Add similar gateway signage and placemaking elements at key nodes along Baltimore Avenue to celebrate North College Park
- » Consider sculpture, artwork, and branding strategies to create a sense of identity for the Hollywood Commercial District
- » Add significantly more wayfinding signs and branding to guide pedestrians and cyclists
- » Consider permanant or temporary tactical urbanism, painted crosswalks/sidewalks/ parking lots, interactive play (especially for the Hollywood Commercial District)
- » Engage the County's Placemaking Team to partner with the community and City of College Park to implement placemaking strategies - work with local artists









Recommended Building Heights

US ROUTE 1

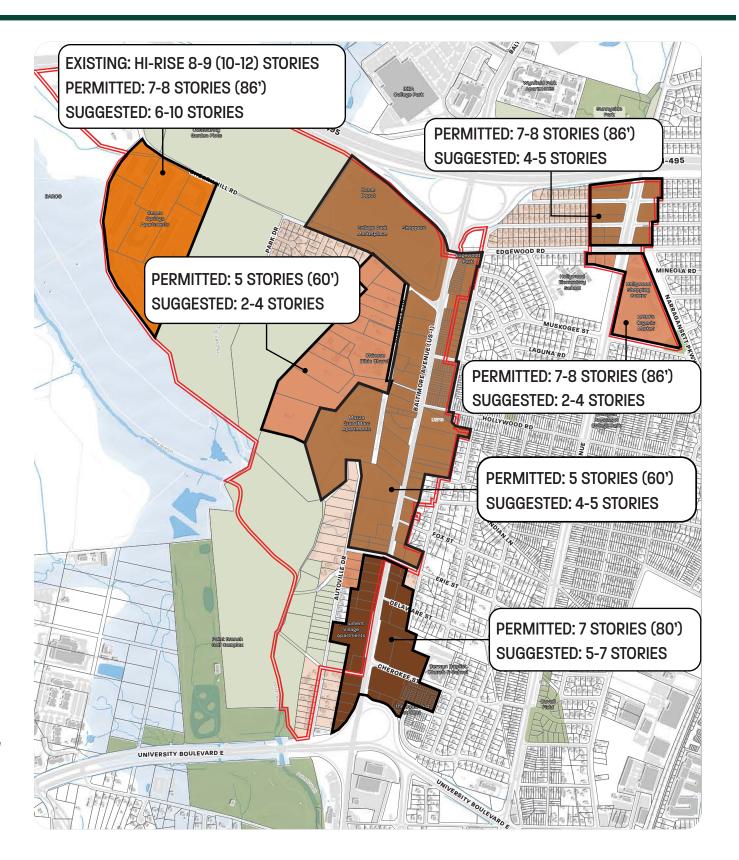
- » 6-10 stories at Seven Springs (orange revised following charrette; existing hi-rise buildings are 8-9 (10-12) -stories)
- » 2-4 stories adjacent to the Paint Branch (peach)
- » 4-5 stories US Route 1 north (tan)
- » 5-7 stories US Route 1 south (brown)

HOLLYWOOD DISTRICT

- » 4-5 stories for the Hollywood Commercial District (tan)
- » 2-4 stories for Hollywood Shopping Center (peach)

GOALS & INCENTIVES - APPROPRIATE TO CONTEXT

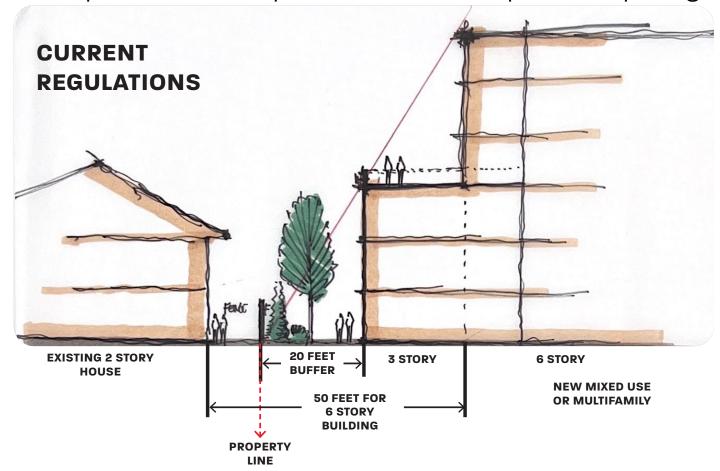
- » Encourage or incentivize neighborhood-serving services, retail, restaurants, and other uses that provide community benefits
- » Incentivize creative adaptive reuse, green/net-zero buildings, affordable housing, and local small business opportunities
- » Provide additional height, shared/reduced parking

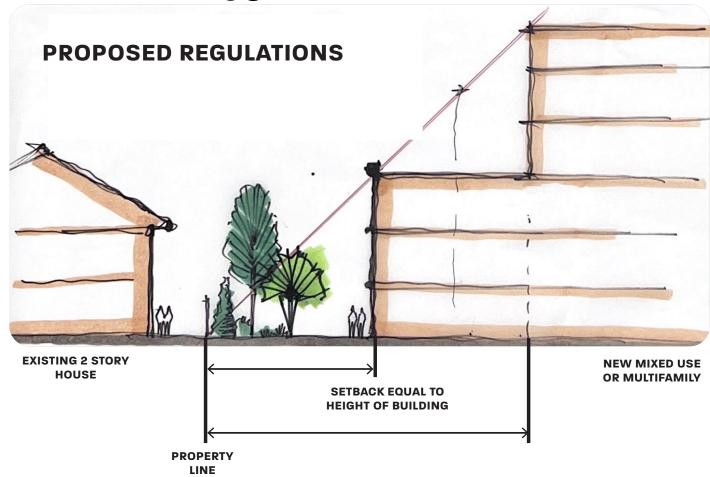


Development Compatibility & Zoning

ADJUST NEIGHBORHOOD COMPATIBILITY STANDARDS

- » Require a minimum 20-foot building setback to the property line of existing single-family homes (the current Type C Bufferyard requirement is 20 feet in an NAC or LTOe zone and 40 feet in the CGO zone)
- » Step the building heights with setbacks equal to the building height.
- » Provide clarity within the standards that prescribes a required massing and scale of the building to be compatible with the scale and massing of adjacent homes (the standards are vague and subjective)
- » Consider varied height standards within the NAC, LTOe, and CGO zones based upon the context rather than a single permitted maximum height for all situations
- » As part of next steps, evaluate development capacity relative to broader county goals

Massing & Building Heights - Existing Zoning - CGO (8 stories)



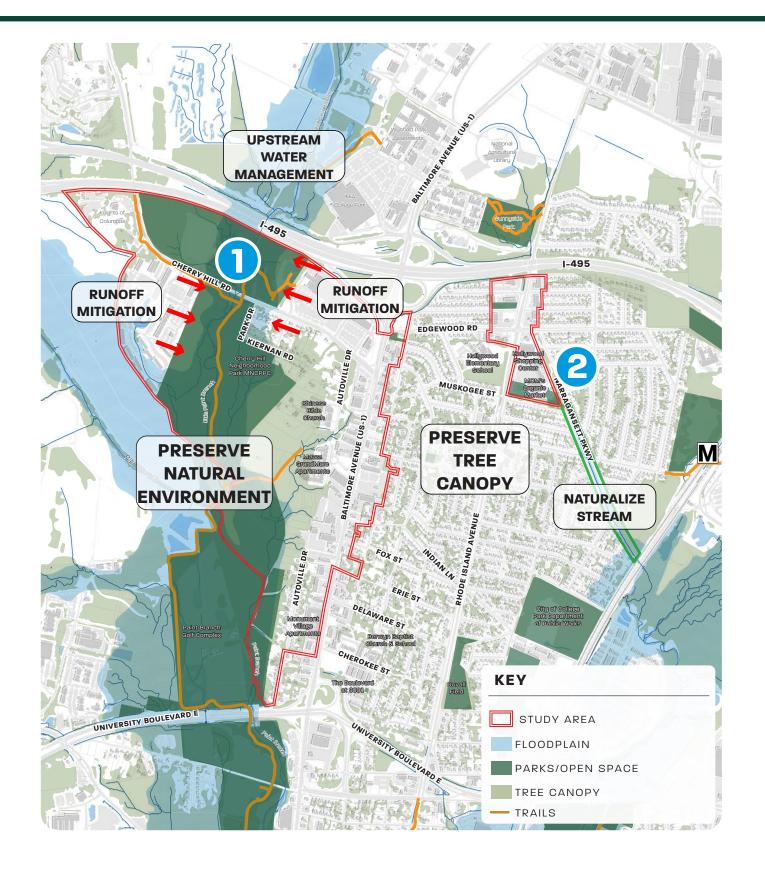

Natural Environment and Flood/Stormwater Plan

- Coordinate with College Park Marketplace to adopt stormwater management practices to reduce runoff into Paint Branch - address upstream water management
- 2. Explore opportunities to plant / naturalize the stream on Narragansett Pkwy to help mitigate localized flooding and improve attractiveness
- » Look for opportunities to strengthen policies, enforce regulations to preserve tree canopy, sustain habitats, and prohibit construction in the floodplain in ROS zones
- » Promote awareness of grant opportunities for residents, businesses, non-profit organizations, and the City of College Park to install small-scale but impactful projects to manage stormwater and limit runoff
- » Identify projects designed to reduce risk to communities
- » Leverage future streetscape investments to install green infrastructure, where feasible
- » Support higher-standard building practices to reduce flood risk while helping to address resiliency
- » Incorporate FEMA standards and sustainable/greenbuilding technologies; prevent displacement





Multimodal Transportation Recommendations

Baltimore Avenue - Corridor Wide

- » Replace the TWLTL with a median (planted where possible) and consolidate left turns at intersections
- » Improve access management through driveway consolidation
- » Work with property owners to develop shared parking facilities on back side of buildings to facilitate access management improvements
- » Install sidewalks at locations with gaps to create continuous sidewalk connections on both sides of Route 1
- » Install crosswalks at all four legs of signalized intersections indicated on map
- Consider installing enhanced crosswalks (pedestrian beacons, passive detection, crossing islands) across Route 1 at unsignalized intersections indicated on map (to be further studied with SHA)
- » Install streetscape elements to match near campus; coordinate with SHA to consider sidewalk graphics (branding, placemaking to add local identity)
- » Improve functionality, attractiveness, safety, lighting, and placemaking / branding for all bus stops along the corridor



Concept Plans - Edgewood Road to Hollywood Road

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Edgewood Road:

- 1. Add missing crosswalks, pedestrian refuge, and narrow lanes to reduce crosswalk length and improve ped safety (where feasible)
- 2. Per SHA recently installed Leading Pedestrian Interval (LPI)

Cherry Hill Road:

- 3. Add red light/ pedestrian beacon for south bound Route 1 to west bound Cherry Hill Road
- 4. Add median to ensure existing RI/RO control (Starbucks; IHOP) and to improve access/egress to/from Autoville Road

General

- 5. Construct a pedestrian/bicycle bridge to connect Autoville Drive / Cherry Hill Road SUP; enable safe access to the Paint Branch Trail
- » Add missing sidewalk from Lackawanna to Edgewood
- » Consolidate curb cuts/driveways and connect/share parking from parcel to parcel, where feasible (coordinate w property owners)
- 6. Consider installing enhanced crosswalks (pedestrian beacons, passive detection, crossing islands) at Lackawanna Street (to be further studied with SHA)

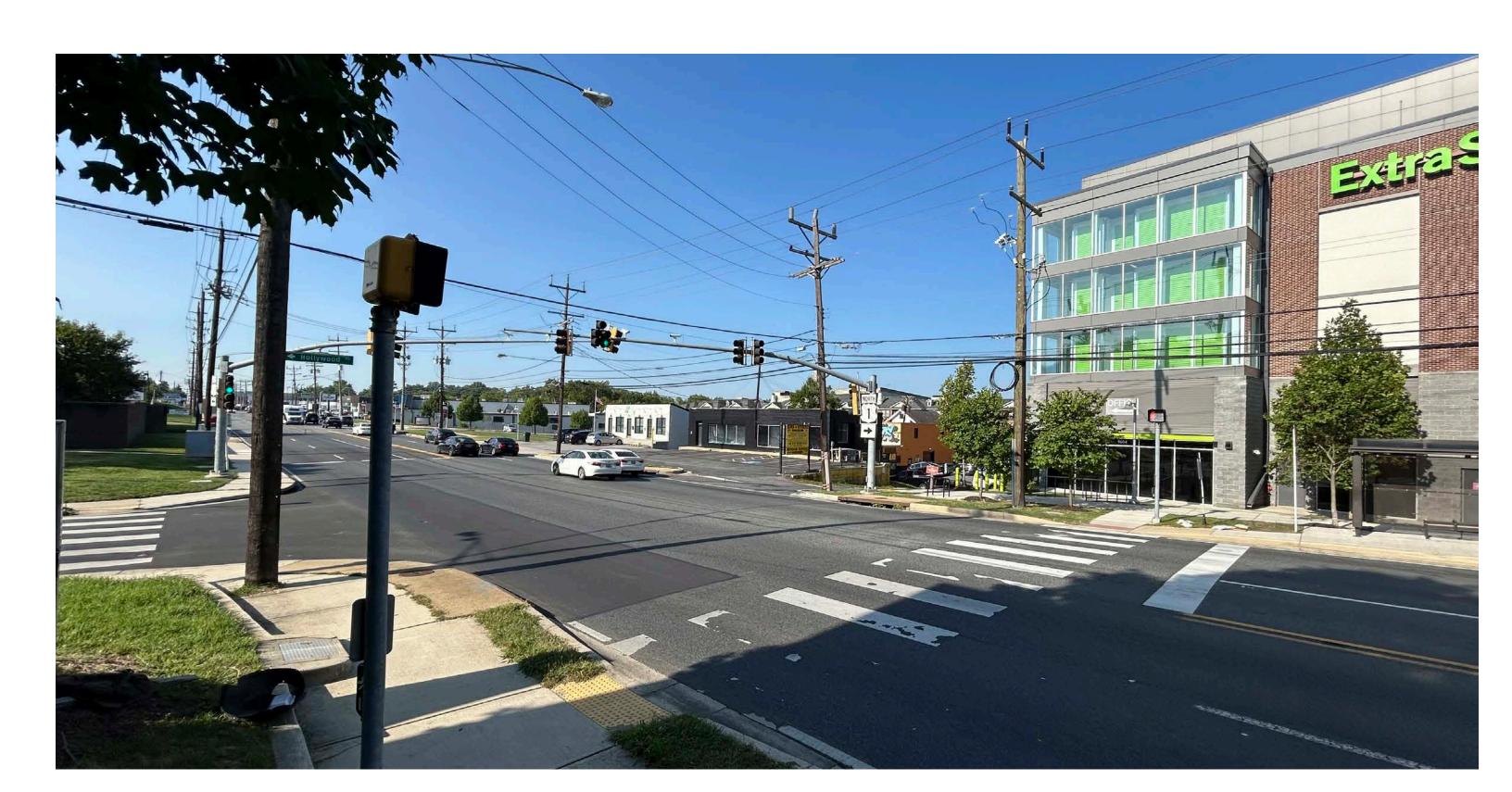
Concept Plans - Hollywood Road to Erie Street

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

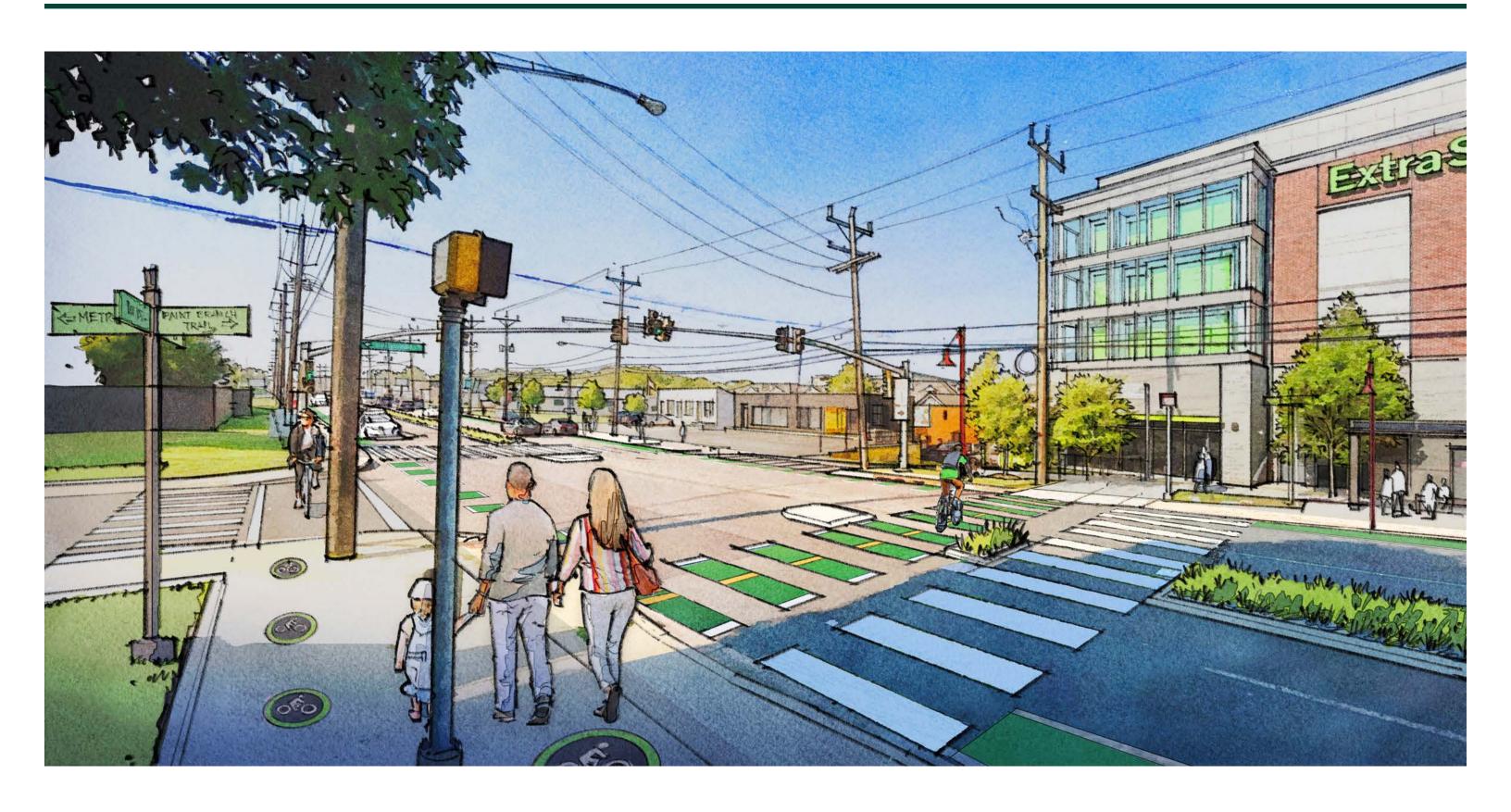
- 1. Provide marked, safe, signalized bicycle crossing at Hollywood Road; extend shared use path to Paint Branch Trailhead TH
- 2. Mark / sign Hollywood Road as a shared street; provide wayfinding (branding, placemaking) directions to the Paint Branch Trail and to Rhode Island Avenue / Hollywood / Metro
- 3. Study the feasbility of constructing a trail behind the auto dealers to connect Autoville Drive
- » Consolidate curb cuts/driveways and connect/share parking from parcel to parcel, where feasible (coordinate w property owners)
- 4. Per SHA median may extend through unsignalized intersections to become RI/RO only
- 5. Request SHA study Erie Street as a signalized intersection with crosswalks (Erie Street includes a bus stop and connects to Autoville Drive whereas Fox Street does not)
- 6. Consider installing enhanced crosswalks (pedestrian beacons, passive detection, crossing islands) at Mazza Grand Marc or Piano Superstore, Indian Lane and/or Erie Street (to be further studied with SHA)

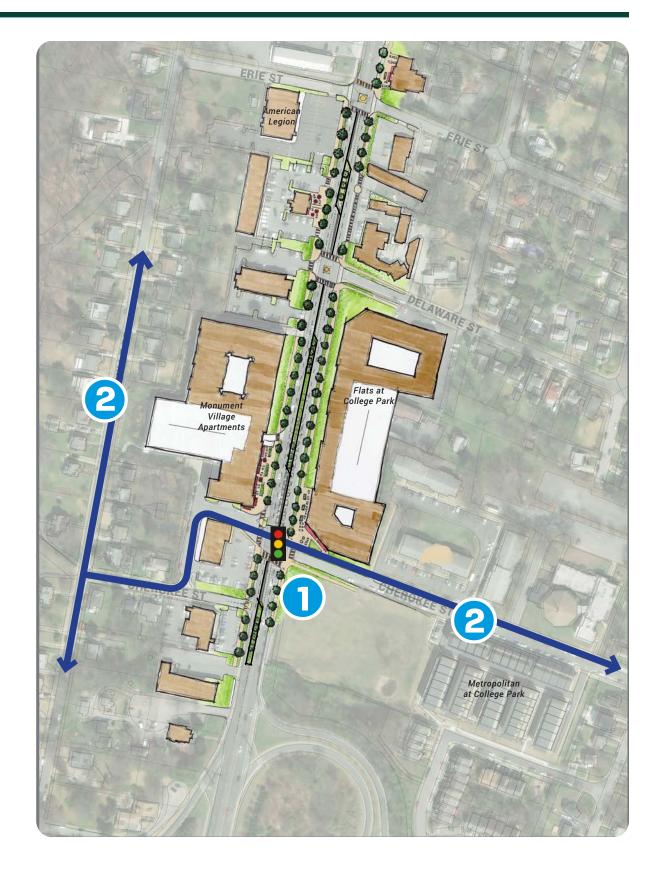
Hollywood Road Intersection - Streetscape Enhancements



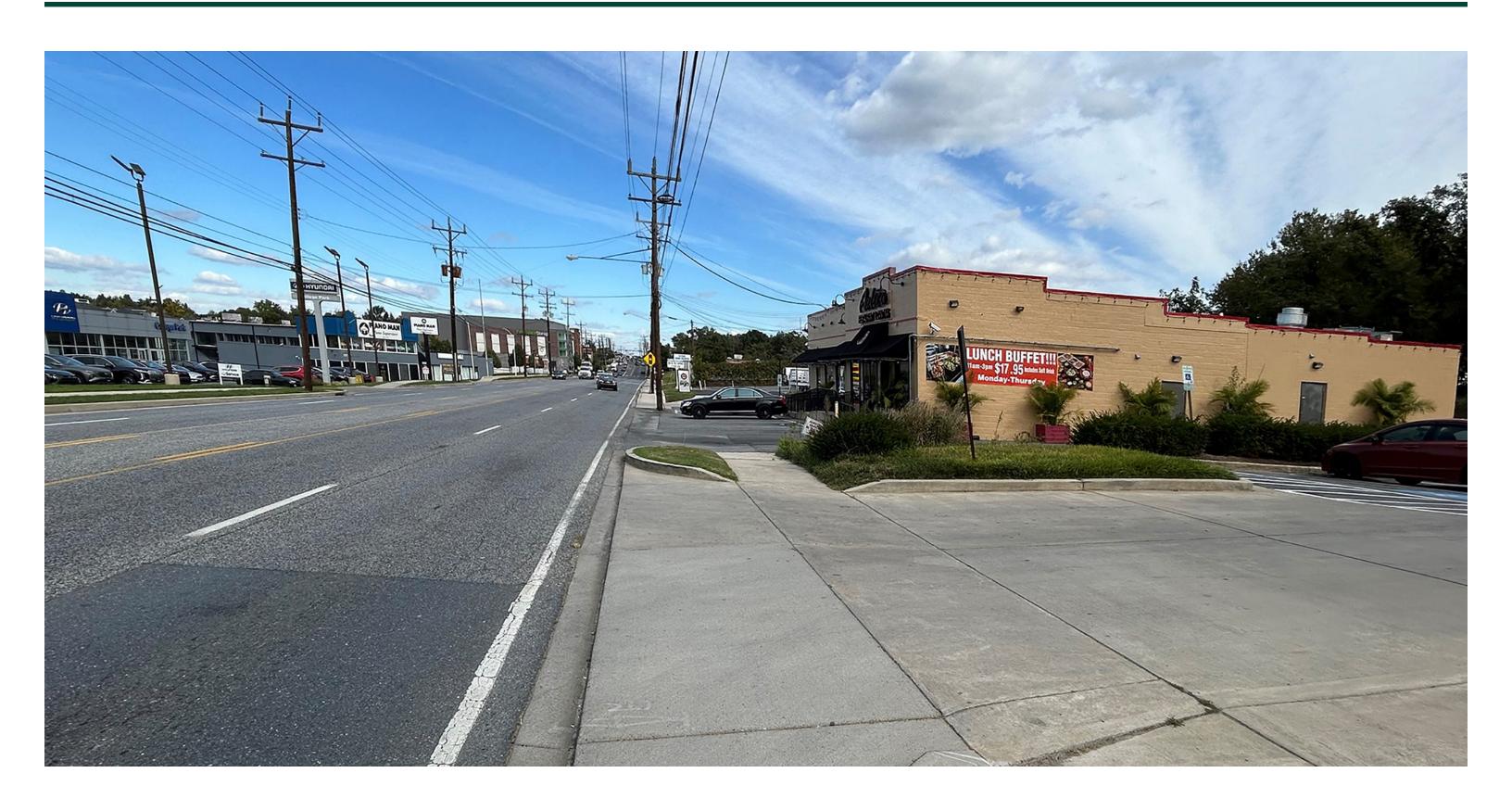
Concept Plans - Erie Street to Cherokee Street

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

- 1. Provide marked, safe, and signalized bicycle crossing at Cherokee Street (similar to Hollywood Road) and connect to Autoville Drive
- 2. Mark / sign Cherokee Street as a shared street; provide wayfinding (branding, placemaking) directions to Autoville Drive and the Paint Branch Trail and to Rhode Island Avenue / Duvall Field
- 3. Consolidate curb cuts and driveways and connect/share parking from parcel to parcel, where feasible
- 4. Per SHA median may extend through unsignalized intersections to become RI/RO only
- 5. Consider installing enhanced crosswalks (pedestrian beacons, passive detection, crossing islands) at Delaware Street

Concept Plans - Edgewood Road to Hollywood Road

LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT, AND PLACEMAKING

- » Building heights: 4-5 stories (consistent w/ 2010 Sector Plan)
- » Anticipate major businesses to remain (IHOP, hotels, office small properties); limited new large-scale development to be addressed in next steps
- » Anticipate small buildings to remain and/or to be repurposed (for example: McCormick Paints or the Tag and Title building as sitdown and fast-casual restaurants, cafes, brewery, neighborhood services)
- » Anticipate small-scale infill on commercial lots under single ownership (for example: senior housing or affordable housing)
- » No drive-thru fast food
- » Property assemblage, although encourged, will be challenging
- » Support facade improvements, site/parking improvements, placemaking/art, and beautification







Concept Plans - Hollywood Road to Erie Street

LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT, AND PLACEMAKING

- » Building heights: 4-5 stories (consistent w/ 2010 Sector Plan)
- » Anticipate limited new large-scale development (for example: the RV & Marine Center) to be addressed in next steps
- » Car dealers will likely remain for the foreseeable future
- » Anticipate businesses to remain and/or be repurposed as sitdown and fast-casual restaurants, cafes, brewery, maker space, indoor recreation, or neighborhood services (for example: Azteca Restaurant, the Piano Superstore, Mattress Land, or Enterprise)
- » Anticipate small-scale infill on small commercial lots (for example: senior housin, affordable housing) to be addressed in next steps
- » No drive-thru fast food
- » Support facade improvements, site/parking improvements, placemaking/art, and beautification
- » Create a small community park, "node," and gathering place at Mazza GrandMarc as part of the new trail connection *







Concept Plans - Erie Street to Cherokee Street

LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT, AND PLACEMAKING

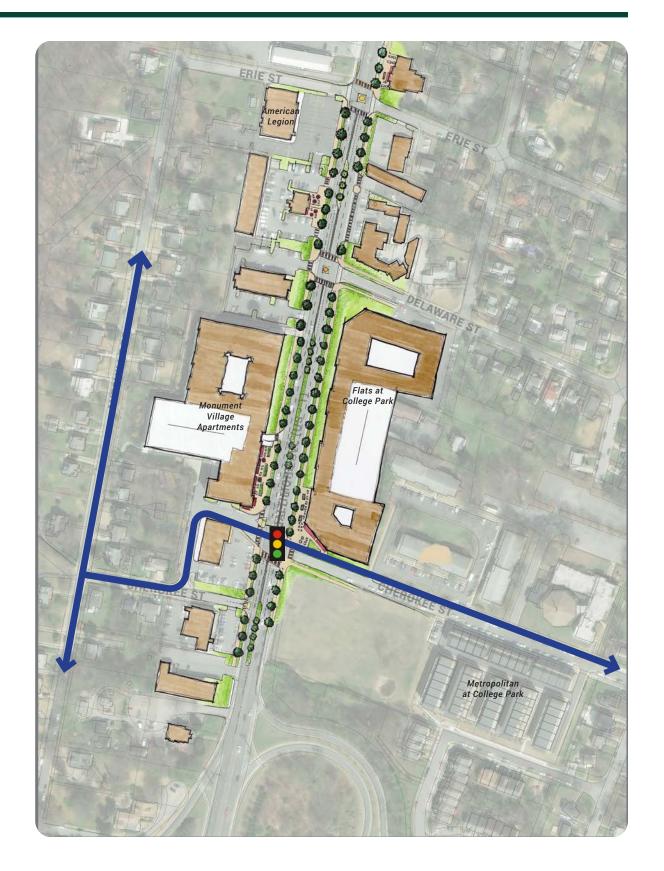
- » Building heights: 5-7 stories (consistent w/ 2010 Sector Plan)
- » Anticipate limited new large-scale development focused around Cherokee and Delaware Streets (for example: the vacant lot south of Cherokee) to be addressed in next steps
- » Anticipate small-scale infill on small commercial lots (such as: senior housing, affordable housing) to be addressed in next steps
- » No drive-thru fast food
- » Anticipate businesses to remain (for example: College Park Diner)
- » Support facade improvements, site/parking improvements, placemaking/art, and beautification
- » Repurposed buildings may become sit-down and fast-casual restaurants, cafes, brewery, or neighborhood services, for example



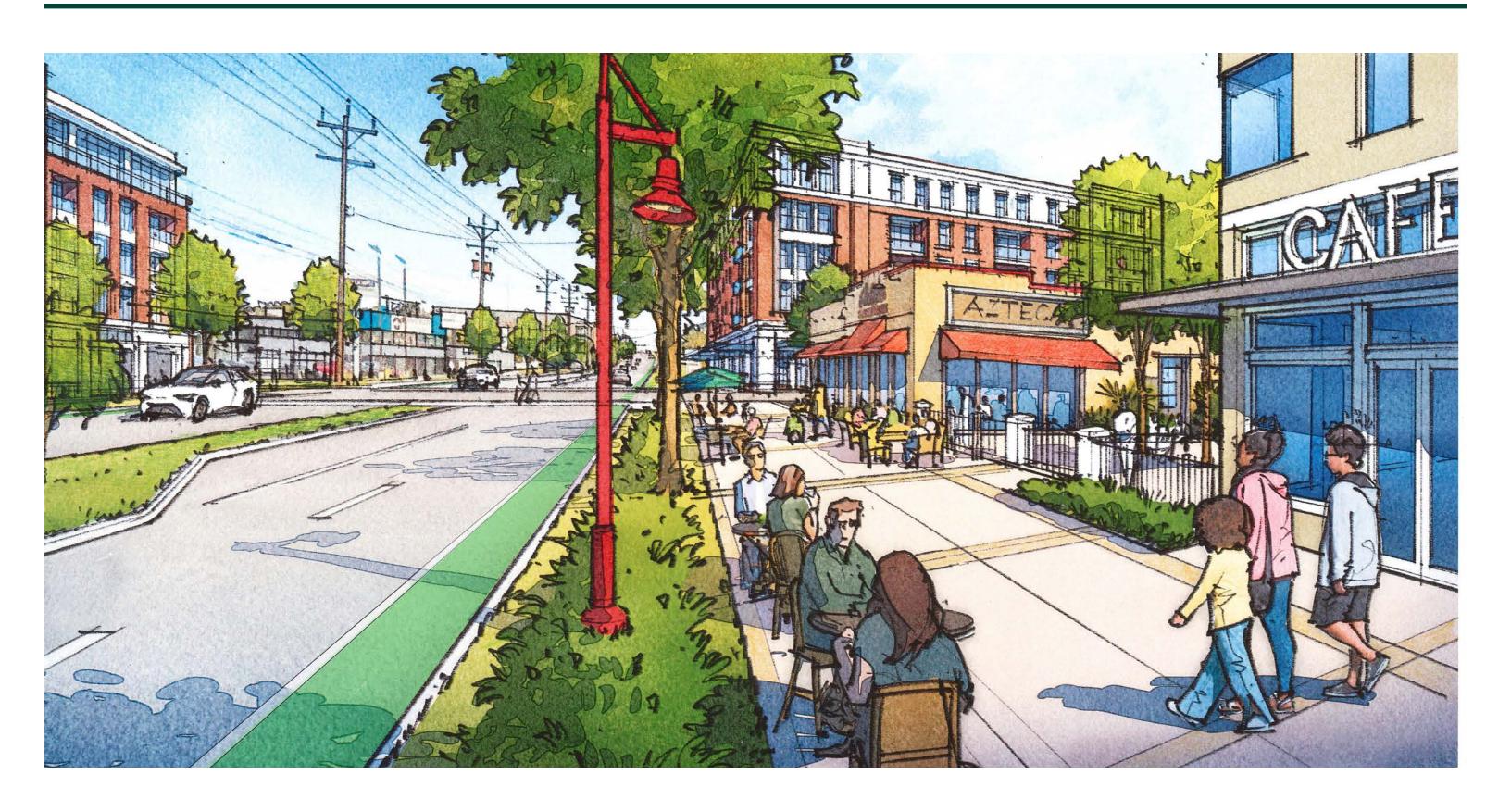

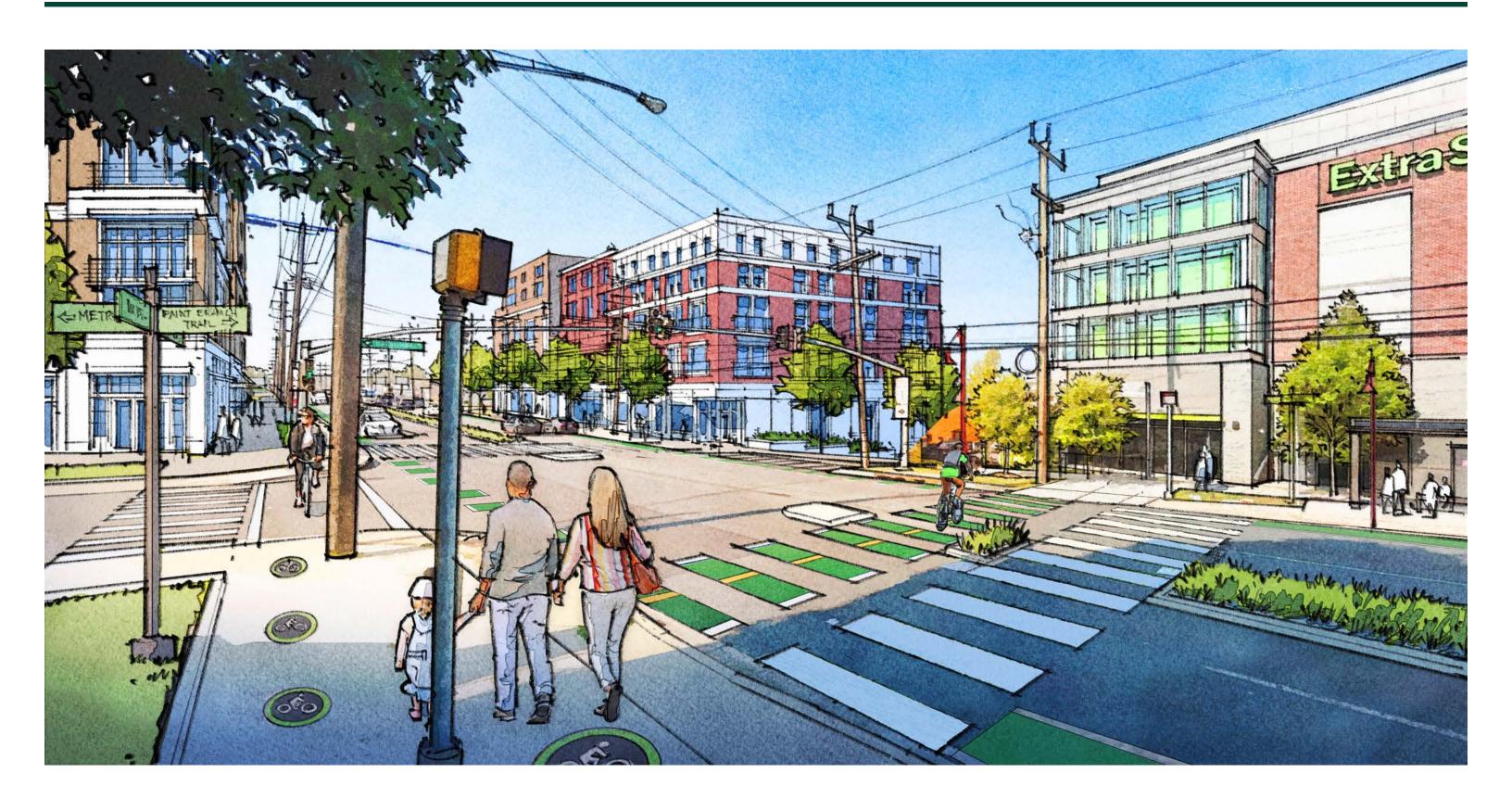

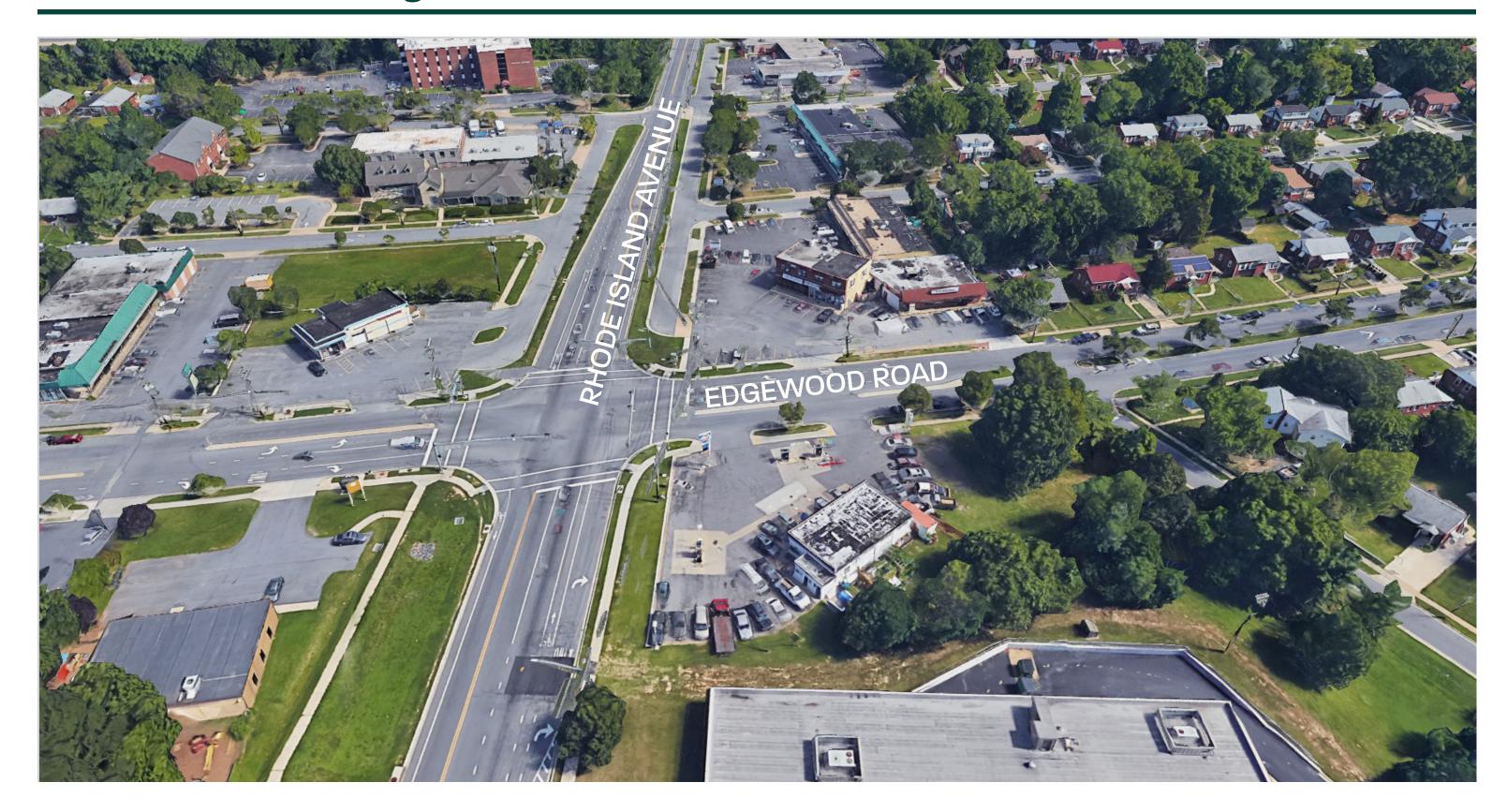

Phase 1 - Enhanced Streetscape and Beautification Plan

Transform Hollywood into vibrant, walkable shopping district with a sense of identity that celebrates local art, culture, and diversity

STREETSCAPE & PLACEMAKING

- » Placemaking and tactical urbanism interventions
- » Improve pedestrian experience with connections and painted crosswalks that link existing blocks, buildings, and tenants to create a cohesive district
- » Create open spaces and enhanced sidewalks for outdoor dining adjacent to storefronts; create potential for closed street festivals
- » Incorporate public art, street graphics, and sculpture (local artists)
- » Incorporate Gateway signage and branding) *
- » Engage the County's Placemaking Section; consider a Placemaking Festival - engage local artists

DEVELOPMENT CHARACTER

- » Anticipate businesses to remain and/or be repurposed with new retail, restaurants, cafes, brewery, or neighborhood services
- » Support facade improvements, site/parking and landscape improvements, enhanced storefronts and tenant signage, and overall beautification
- » Investigate grants, micro loans, and local County and City of College Park fund sources



Hollywood Commercial District - Rhode Island Avenue

Long Term - A Community-Focused Walkable Village & Main Street

STREETSCAPE AND PLACEMAKING

- » Incorporate similar streetscape and placemaking elements in streets, parking lots, and pedestrian zones
- » Connect to Hollywood Shopping Center and create a walkable, multiblock, identifiable shopping district
- » Construct permanent gateway, placemaking, directional and branding elements at the northern, southern, eastern, and western gateway entry points *
- » Create a permanent events or farmers market space adjacent to the proposed Hollywood Community Center **

DEVELOPMENT CHARACTER

- » Longer term phased redevelopment to create a more engaging, connected, village-like character
- » Rhode Island Avenue is the community's "Walkable Main Street"
- » Phase redevelopment (10-20+ years) to potentially include mixeduse buildings with locally-owned ground floor retail, restaurants, commercial businesses, and neighborhood services
- » Upper floors to potentially include a mix of housing types such as affordable, senior, workforce, or market rate housing

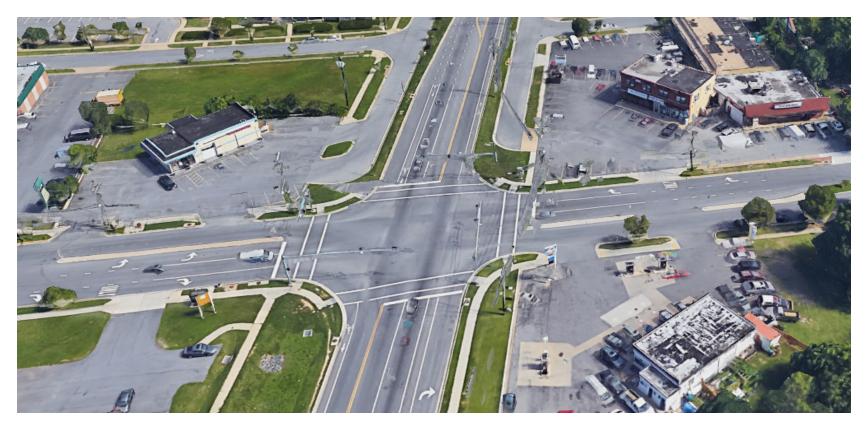
East-West Connection

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

- » Raised Crosswalks
- » Raised/Tabled Intersection
- » Painted Crosswalks
- » Explore opportunities to reduce the street cross-section on one or more intersection approaches to reduce crossing distance
- » Consider barrier-separated bicycle lanes along Rhode Island Avenue (per GOPGC)





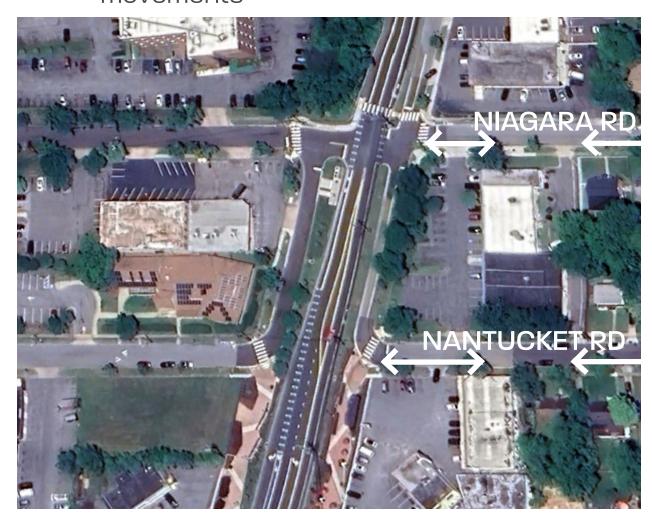


Recommendations East-West Connection

Nantucket Road

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

- » Right-in Right-out at Rhode Island Avenue study potentil for full intersection
- » Remove the frontage lane and repurpose as sidewalk, streetscape, plaza, and/or open space
- » Maintain all other streets and 1-way movements

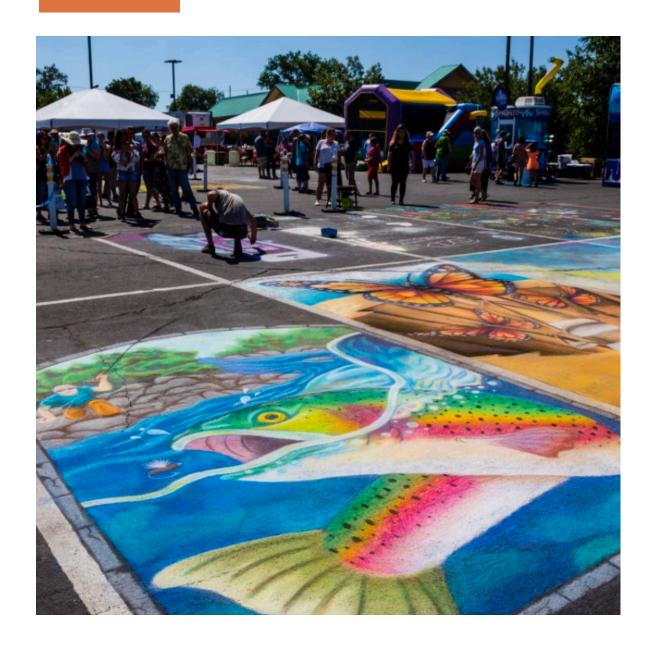

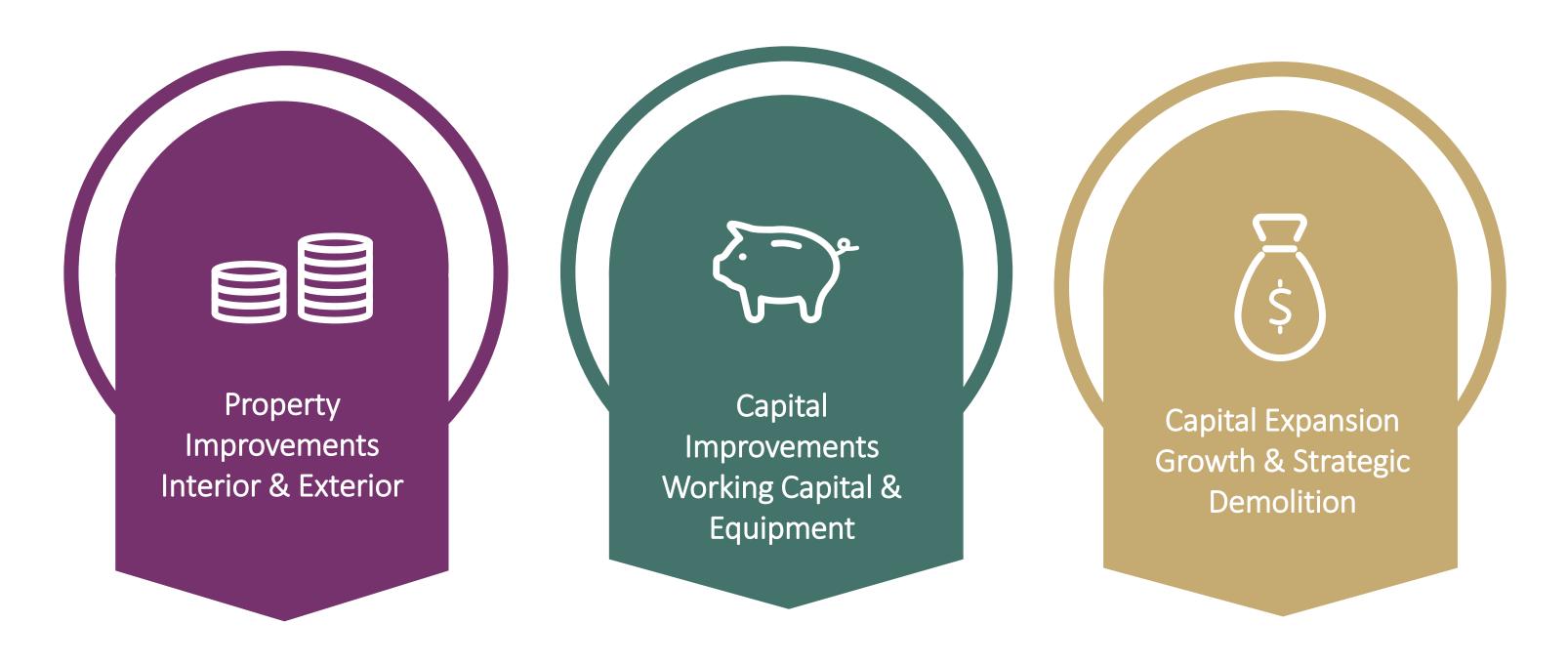

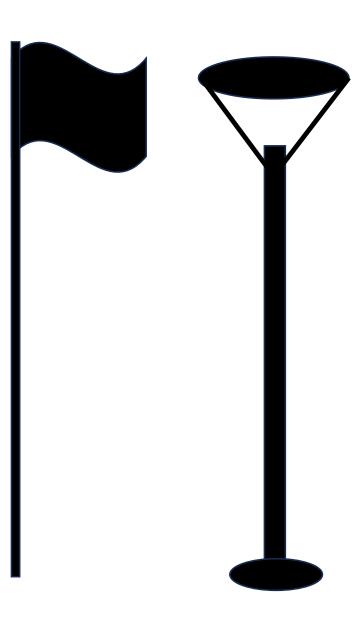
